- Bhavin Shah, Bharat Doshi, Jayant Lodaya, Haresh Shah, Girish Sanghvi suggested immediately working on redeveloping the website and develop The Jain Sangh mobile app for a smartphone. The process may get delayed as EC does not have check writing authority.
- IN January various **Committees formation** will be done after communicating with individuals to join the particular committee. Devji Dedhia proposed 8 committees. EC may add more committees as needed.
- **YJA Cloth Drive:** EC unanimously approved to put boxes to collect clothes. Blankets, Jackets, Coats, etc....in good condition will be accepted
- **Water leak at the entrance:** EC will soon start working on fixing a long time continuous water leak at the lobby after entrance. “Bharat Shah suggested cutting the 8’ X 8.’ area – Get a professional – find the hole and get it fixed permanently.” Bhavin Shah requested checkbook to pay for such fixing cost. The current Executive Committee does not have any access to funds to make payments for such repairs.
- **A security system** for the entire facility is dysfunctional at present. Bharat Doshi, Jayant Lodaya, Haresh Shah will contact Independent Alarm System to put security system back in order.
- EC is preparing notes for Dr. Vinod Shah – EC Treasurers would like to get the checkbook so that payments can be made in the event of outstanding amounts or bills in his absence.
- **Financial Update:**
 - **Transition Update:** No Update provided by Harshad Shah regarding Transition as required on 11/26/18. No emails or any form of communication for Sangh Finances has been received from Harshad Shah as agreed with Dr. Vinod Shah as per meeting on 11/18/2018.
 - **November Finance Update:** Bhavin Shah or Jayant Lodaya could not provide an update for finances for November as none of the access has provided. Bhavin Shah informed the executive committee only Harshad Shah could do finances for the Sangh as none of the existing members

are aware of how to manage and complete the Transition for the finances for the Sangh. Bhavin Shah highlighted this is a risk for the Sangh that only one person has accountability for the finances without any oversight from anyone.

- **Financial Access:** Harshad Shah has not yet provided any information such as quick book access, income/expense information. Other financial information, passwords for the server, Computer Password, passwords for the surveillance system, Keys to the office room, access to all such things to Bhavin Shah. He (Bhavin Shah) currently has no access to anything which had promised on November 18th meeting. A promise made that Harshad Shah would give all the above and more access on 26th November 2018 immediately upon his arrival from overseas.
- **Future Bhandar Openings:** The Bhandar opened without any notification to the incoming treasurer or it the treasurer or without any communication to the Sangh. No report has provided to the Executive Committee as to who collected the cash, who deposited the money or how much was collected.
- The EC will send out the notice to The Sangh about Bhandar openings and seek help from Sangh members and Pathshala Students with counting,
