MEETING MINUTES

This meeting took place in-person (*Via: Zoom Video Teleconference*) by individuals mentioned above on Tuesday, July 31, 2020, at 8.30 pm.

A meeting quorum was met and called to order at 8.38 pm.

Meeting started by the recital of *Navkar Mahamantra* by Devji Dedhia.

1. Approval of Meeting Minutes of July 14, 2020.

Bhavin Shah proposed to approve meeting minutes, Girish Sanghvi seconded the proposal.

Executive Committee unanimously approved the minutes of July 14, 2020 meeting.

2. Financial updates and reports from Treasurer, Bhavin Shah

- ***Quarterly Financial Statement and authorization to transfer additional funds from Citizens Bank to Bank Of America bank account.***

Bhavin Shah informed that Quarterly Financial Statements for quarter ending June 30, 2020 are in process and he will submit them in next EC meeting.

To minimize the financial risks for having lots of money in Citizens Bank and to maintain minimum daily balance in Bank of America account, Bhavin Shah recommended transferring \$50,000 from Citizens Bank operating account to Bank of America Account. Executive Committee unanimously approved this authorization.

3. Final Paryushan Plan:

Bhavin Shah and Haresh Shah gave the Survey updates and analysis. Following is the survey analysis.

- Total 133 families responded the survey

- Almost 205 individuals wanted to do *Chandan Pooja* and/or *Chaityavandan* and/or *Darshan*.
- *Chandan Pooja* and *Chaityavandan*: Head Count is almost 165 individuals during weekend and almost 65 individuals during weekdays of *Parushan Week*.
- *Darshan Only*: Headcount is almost 50 individuals throughout the *Parushan Week*.

Girish Sanghvi proposed for “*Darshan Only*” for general public. EC Members discussed the survey results thoroughly. For safety of our Sangh Members, Executive Committee unanimously approved the following resolution.

- I. Temple will be open during *Parushan* from 9 am to 1 pm during weekends and from 9 am to noon during weekdays for “*Darshan Only*” activity for Sangh Members for 20 minutes. EC may extend these timings as per needed basis.
 - II. Sangh Members are required to schedule the online appointment schedule. 12 families (up to four individuals per family) can schedule the appointment for every 20 minutes interval.
- For *Snatra Pooja* and *Swapna Darshan Labharthi* Families, only immediate family members will be allowed to participate in activities.

All above-mentioned resolutions were approved and adopted by all in-person (*via: Zoom Video teleconference*) Executive Committee Members of the Jain Sangh, Inc.

The meeting was adjourned at 10.07 pm with a recital of Manglik by Chintan Shah.
